Steven came to us to work on a placement as part of the Leonardo e-PICTURE project, based at Hogeschool West-Vlaanderen department PIH, Belgium.

When Steven arrived with us, he was given a project brief to develop an interactive guide to the FACT building, that could be used for potential visitors to the building and also for those who may potentially wish to hire the spaces in the building.

Steven has undertaken the project with a very high sense of commitment, working much longer hours than might be anticipated from a student placement, and always with diligence, patience and good humour. He has needed to be self-motivated, as there have been periods when we have been unable to provide him with close direction, but he has demonstrated he is more than capable of moving forward responsibly and capably when left to his own devices. He has demonstrated considerable technical skills and aptitude, quickly learning new tools when required and carefully applying those skills he already possesses with consideration and restraint (a factor that is not always apparent in those learning new skills). He has worked hard to produce a final product that is good-looking, sophisticated and technically thought-through.

Overall Steven has endeared himself to many of the staff in the organisation and we will be sorry to see him leave. I have no doubt that Steven will be a great asset to any organisation who may be able to offer a platform for his positive attitude, good nature and substantial skills.
